License Renewal Requirements

All Nevada Licenses and Registrations expire December 31 of odd-numbered years regardless of original issue date. (NRS 641D.360)

Renewal process will start in October 2024. Continuing Education Requirements (NRS 641D.360) for LBAs & LaBAs:

- 2 Hours** of instruction on *evidence-based suicide prevention & awareness*
- 6 Hours** of instructions relating to *cultural competency and diversity, equity and inclusion.* (NRS 449.103)
